

WHAT IS OUR *Program?*

Kids Great Getaway is a fun-filled four days of activities planned with 4th through 6th graders in mind. Campers are placed in cabin groups with children their age and two counselors who are with them day and night during camp. Activities include recreation, missions, chapel, quizzing, swimming, hiking, treasure hunting, and enjoying the beauty of God's world in a camp setting.
